### WORSHIP HELPS

\*Hymn: "Great and Marvelous" *see attached Powerpoint slides or HS 48*  
*3 minutes*

\*"We Open Ourselves to the Spirit"  
*4 minutes*

*You will need a chime or bell and a candle with matches.  
Suggest to the congregation that they free their hands. You may want to offer a word of explanation to help participants feel comfortable with the symbols, motions and language used in this ritual. The chime or bell sounds a call to prayer; the 'peace' candle is lit to signify our church's ongoing commitment to share Christ's peace; the language is crafted from ancient texts as well as Restoration scripture.*

Chime sounds three times.

As the sound diminishes the leader says: ***Listen to the voice of the Spirit.***

(Pause for one breath)

Leader and congregation say: ***We listen.***

Silence for five seconds.

Chime sounds once.

As the sound diminishes the leader says: ***Trust in the work of the Spirit.***

(Pause for one breath)

Leader and Congregation say: ***We trust.***

Silence for five seconds.

Chime sounds once.

As the sound diminishes the leader says: ***Receive the light of the Spirit.***

(Pause for one breath)

Leader and Congregation say: ***We receive.***

Silence for five seconds.

Chime sounds three times.

The candle is lit while the chime sounds.

Leader says: ***We open ourselves to the Spirit as we offer our silent prayers.***

(Leader models cupping hands during the prayer.)

Silence for fifteen seconds.

Chime sounds once.

Leader: ***We share the peace of Jesus Christ.***

(Leader models moving hands outward from the center or upward.)

Silence for five seconds.

Chime sounds once.

Leader says: ***Let the Spirit breathe.***

(Pause for one breath)

ALL: ***Amen.***
